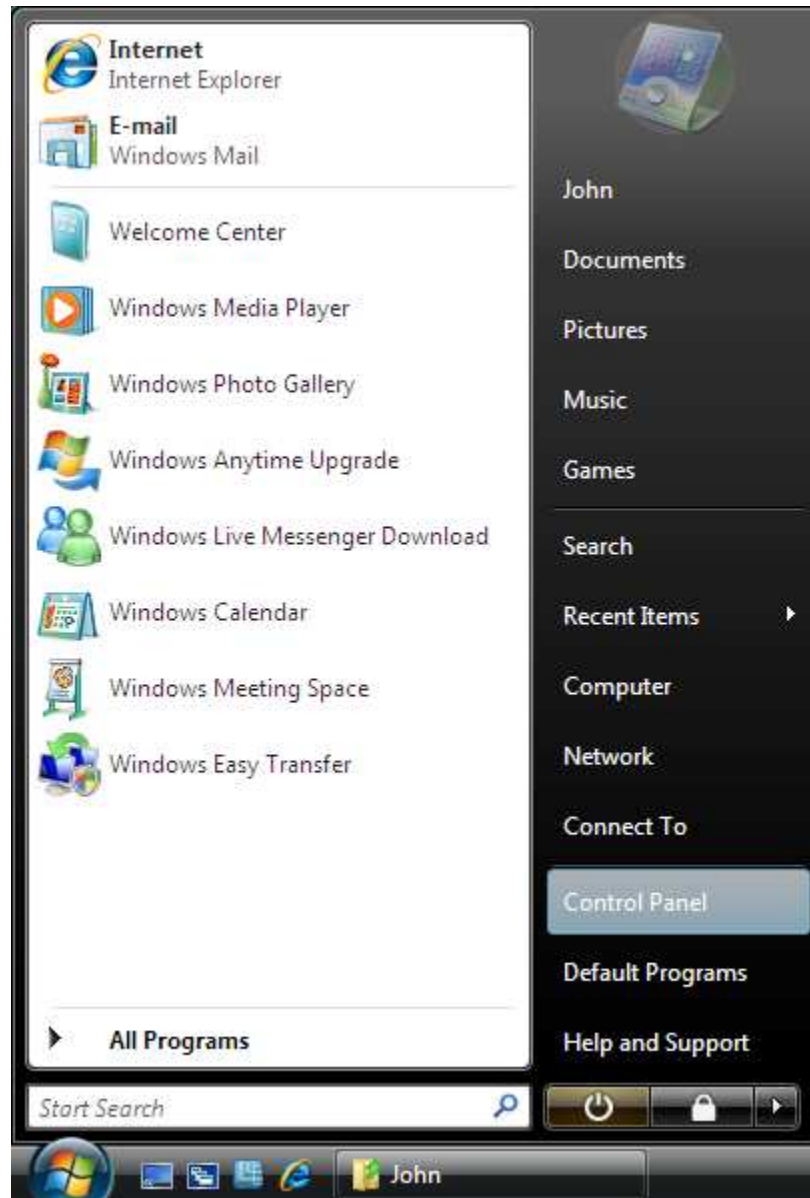
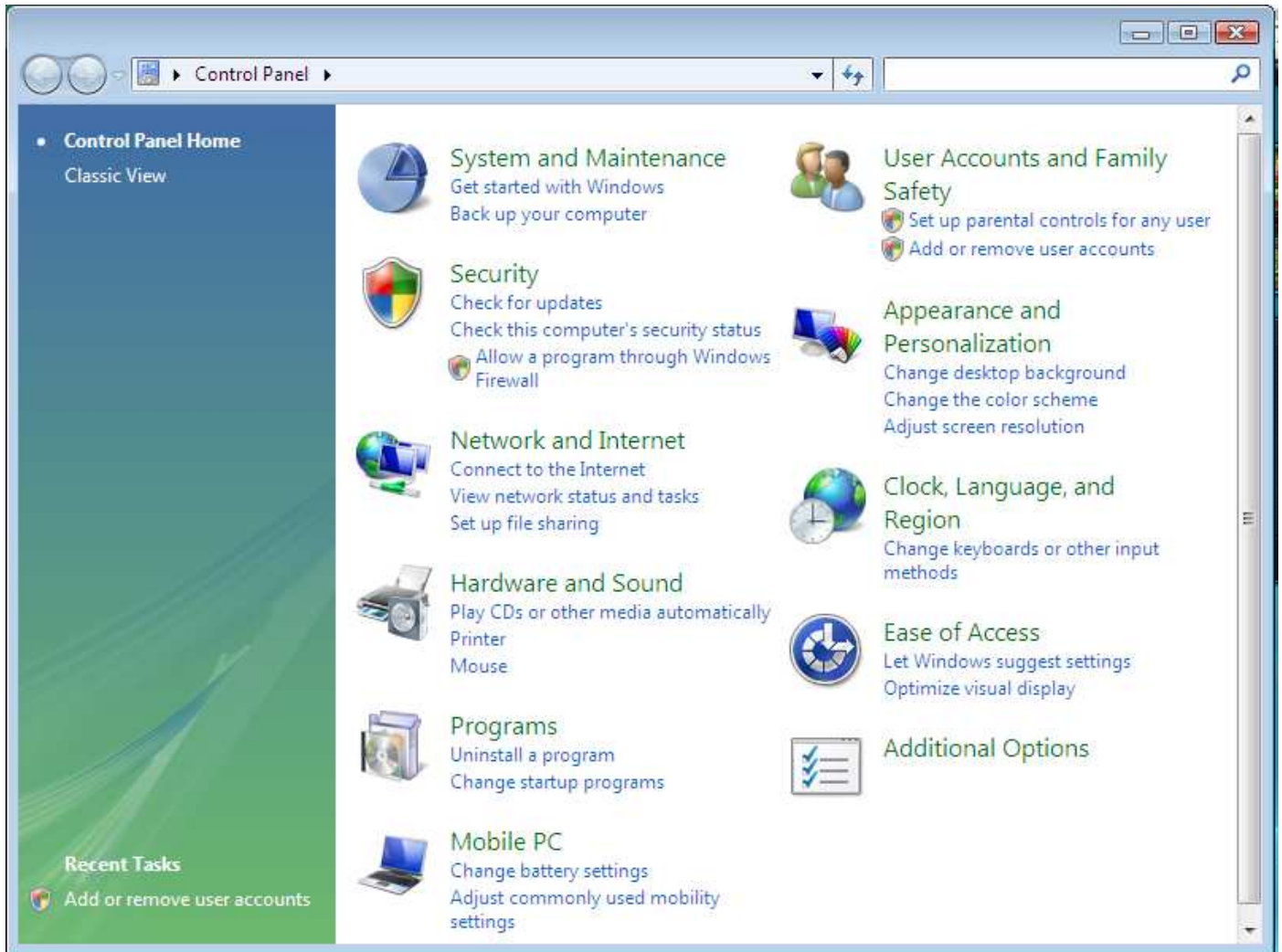


Step 1. Open the *Start* menu and choose *Control Panel*.



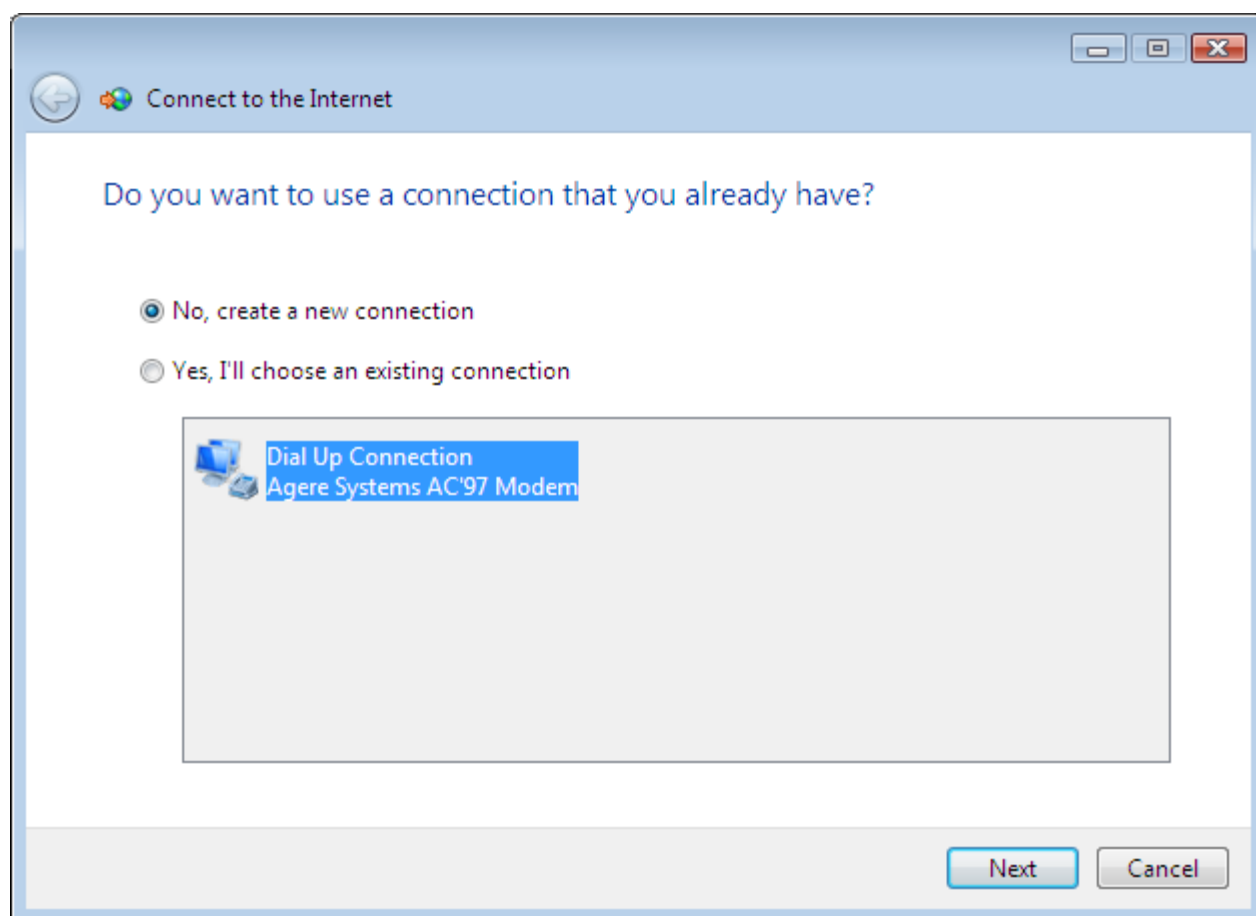

Step 2. Select **Connect to the Internet** in the **Control Panel Home**, If your Control Panel does not look like this please click on **Control Panel Home**.

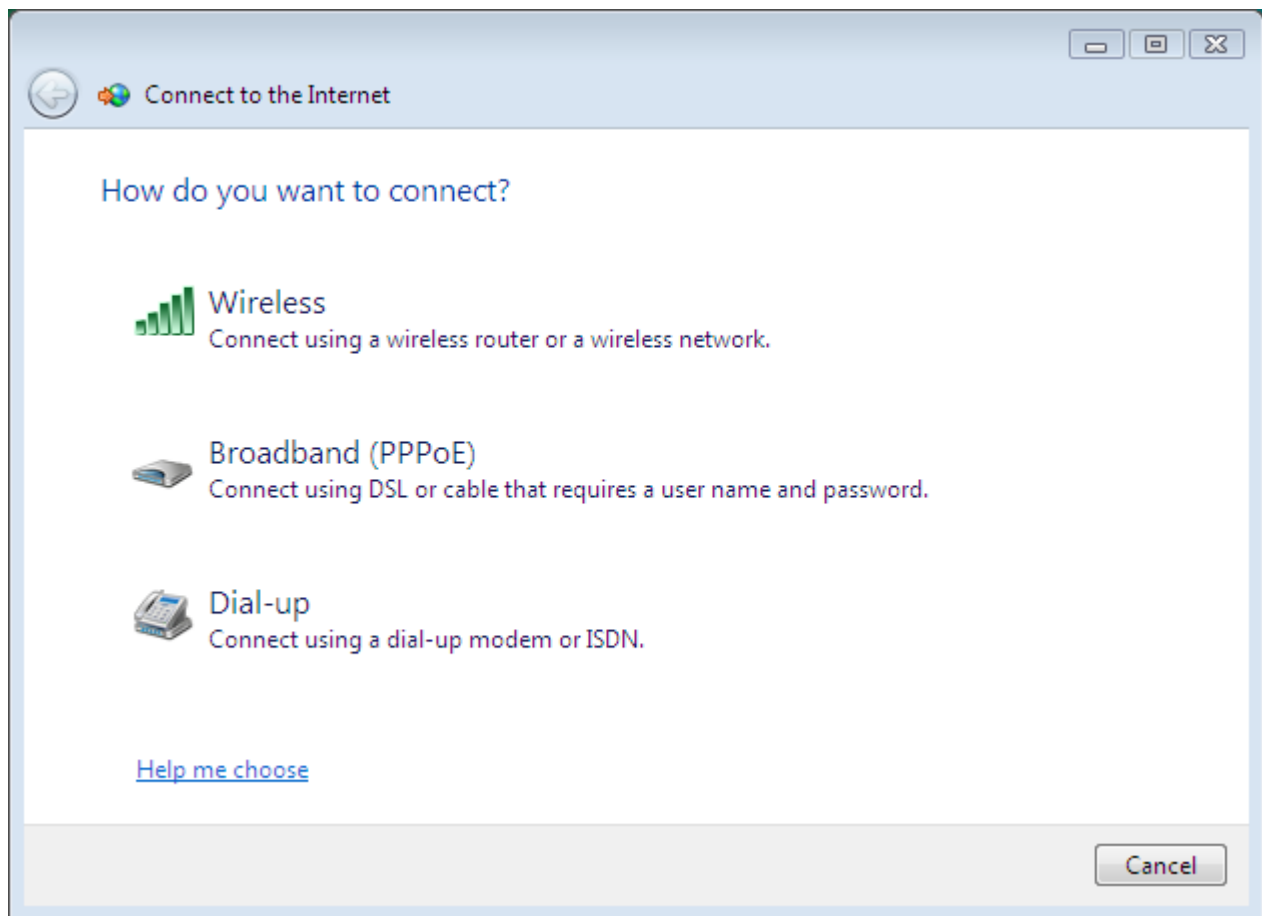


Step 3. You can skip this step if you do not see the screen below after completing previous directions. It will display only if there is an existing dial up account .

Step 5. Enter the **Dial-up phone number** for your area.



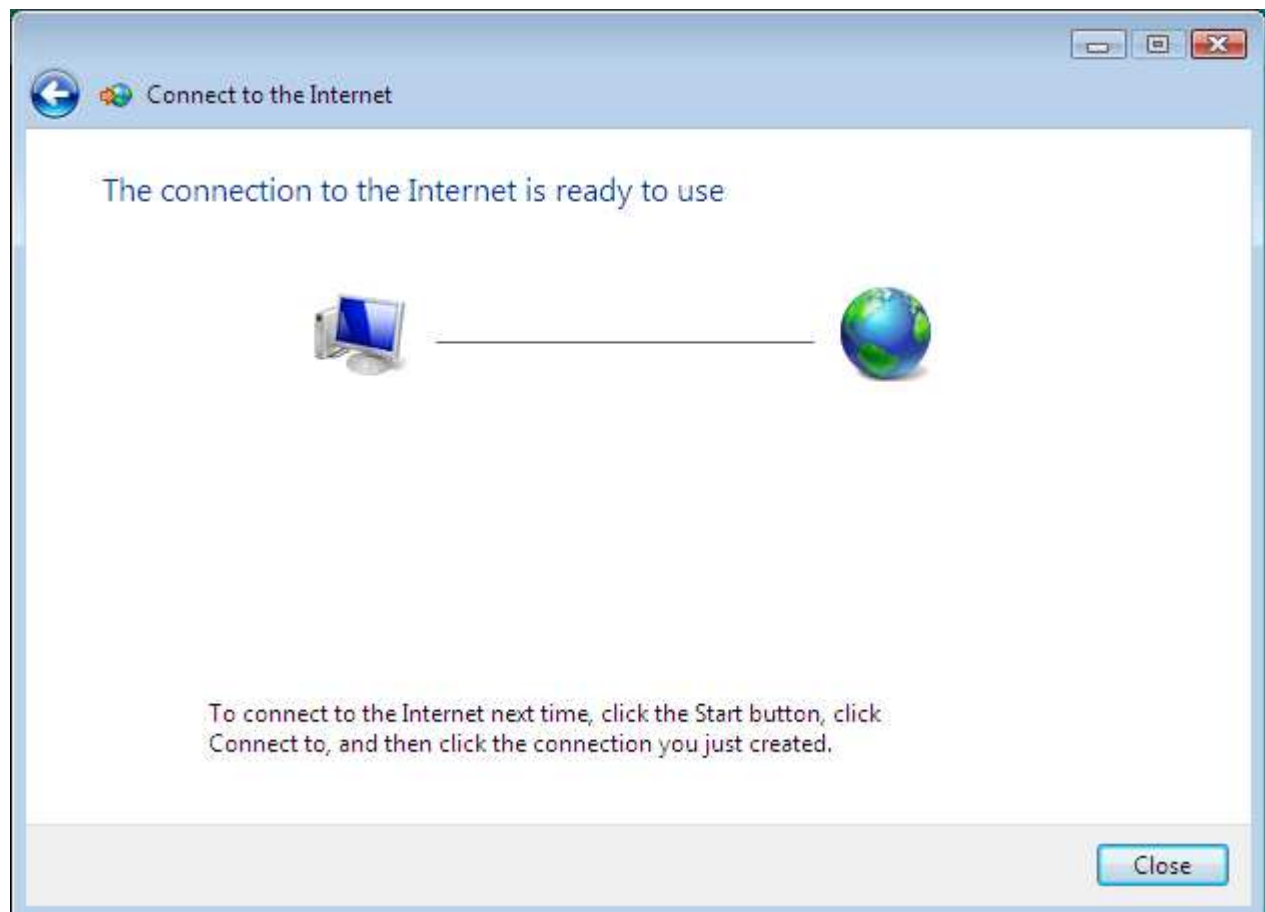
